


Wonder Valley Christian Camp has a great heritage of lives changed for Christ. Every year, since 1946, young people have planned their summers around time spent in "The Valley."



If we hope to attract more people and reach them with the hope offered in Christ, we must expand our schedule of events, offering varied opportunities for busy families.



"The Meadow" with proposed new facilities




Upper Floor Plans of New Dorm
