Refund policy

Deposit is due with registration to secure enrollment. Remaining fee due at check-in.

If registration is cancelled by either the individual or WVCC, you will be contacted through your registration email to find out your wishes:

- a) Donate my payment to the ministry of WVCC.
- b) Transfer some or all the amount paid to another camper, OR transfer to next summer.
- c) Issue a full refund of my payment.

Cleaning Protocols

- Our protocol has always been to clean and disinfect our buildings between each event.
- We will have additional hand sanitizer stations available around campus.
- Hand soap and paper towels are available next to every sink on campus
- Cleaning supplies are available in every building.

Additional policies

Before Camp

Prior to event, campers track their temperature/symptoms and exposure.

Please DO NOT attend if you have symptoms or known exposure relating to Covid-19

Check-In

- Signed affidavit stating that camper has not had Covid-19 symptoms or exposure 2 weeks prior to event.
- Only one parent/guardian and the camper may attend check-in.
- Parent/Guardian will NOT be allowed into the dorms.
- Signed waiver stating you understand the risk and will not hold WVCC, staff, faculty, campers, or parents responsible if sickness arises.
- Health Checks will be as usual with temperature and lice check.

Check-out

- Again, only one parent/guardian to pick up the camper.
- Faculty will help students gather belongings, no parent/guardian in the dorms.

Note: There is an inherent risk of illness spreading through any camp setting.

- While we have always sought to reduce that risk, it has happened in the past and can still happen, even with extra measures in place.
- While we are doing all that is reasonable and prudent to maintain a healthy environment at camp, there is no way we can guarantee complete safety.
- **By sending your child to camp you are accepting that risk.**
